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Vajrasattva practice: The purpose of the Vajrasattva meditation is to purify the negative karma and defilements. Above the crown of my head, sitting on a lotus and moon disc, is the Lama Vajrasattva. His body is white in colour, he is adorned with ornaments, he has one face and two hands, holding a Vajra in the right [hand] and a bell in the left [hand]. He is sitting in the posture [of bodhisattva]. The light emanates from his heart inviting multitudes of deities of primordial wisdom (Yeshepas) dissolving [into him]; we meditate Vajrasattva as the essence of the union of the Three Jewels. We recite: "Lama Vajrasattva, myself and all sentient beings as vast as the space, we pray you to purify us from all the accumulations of negative karma, defilements, faults and downfalls." By this prayer, a stream of nectar flows from the hundred syllables mantra surrounding the syllable Hung on the moon disc at the heart [of Vajrasattva]; then the nectar flows from his

body and fill my body through the Brahma aperture, purifying all my negative karma, faults and downfalls. Recite as much as possible the hundred syllables mantra and the six syllables mantra. Then, joining the hands at the heart, recite: "Protector, by ignorance and blindness, I have broken my vows. Protector Lama, protect me! Lord, Holder of vajra, embodiment of the great compassion, Lord of all beings, I take refuge in you. I confess all my broken samaya vows of the Body, Speech and Mind. Bless me that all my negative karma, defilements, faults and downfalls be purified." Vajrasattva grants my absolution, melts into light and mingles with me, inseparable.
